- have been employed by one or more institutions of higher education in the State of Oklahoma on a full-time basis for a minimum of ten years.
- In addition, individuals not employed by an institution of higher education in Oklahoma, but who have performed outstanding meritorious service to higher education in the state may be considered for induction.

The 2011 Oklahoma Higher Education Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony and Banquet will be held on October 11 at the Jim Thorpe Museum & Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame in Oklahoma City.
